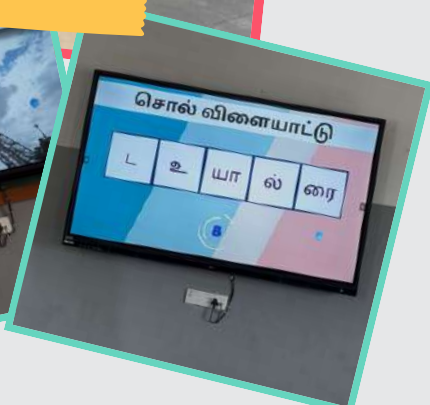
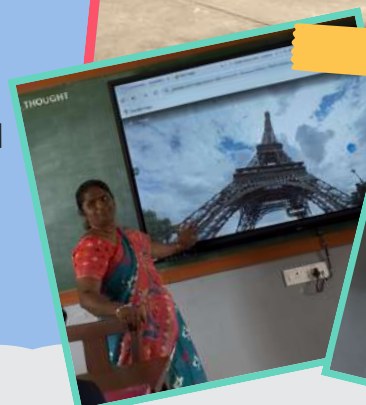
### Fun Meet Focus:

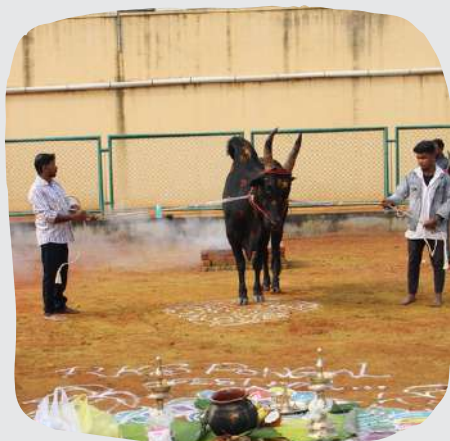




# PONGAL CELEBRATION

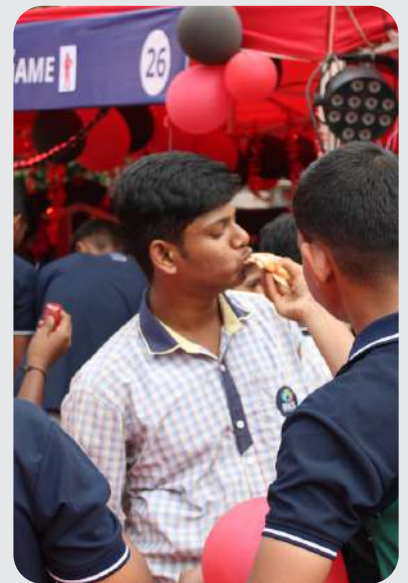
The experience wasn't just about sales and profit—it offered a rich learning platform where students:
