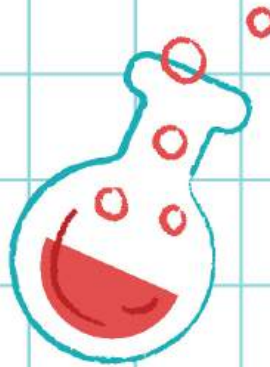
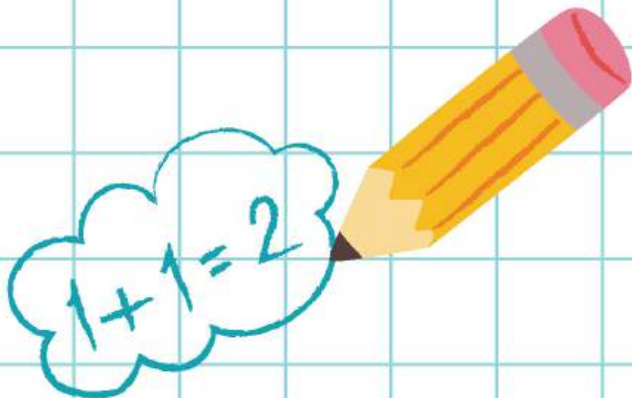

New York, USA in 1978, all in Electrical Engineering.

He began his career as an Assistant Professor in Engineering Science at Pennsylvania  
State University in 1978, achieving Full Professor status in 1987. After his dedicated  
service, Dr. Ashok retired in 2017 and now holds the esteemed title of Professor Emeritus.
